believes in keeping People safe.

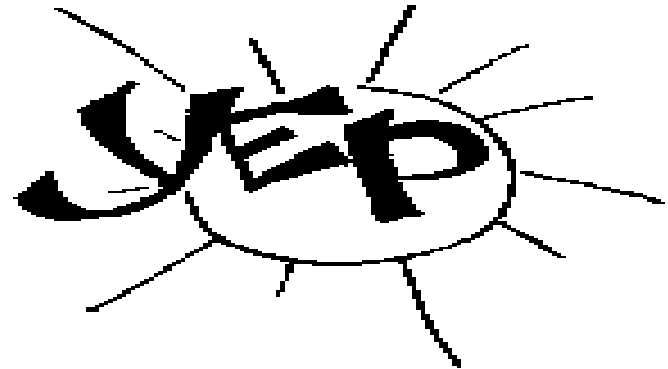
We believe all people are different with each
